

Introduction to the Audi Club High Performance Driver Education Events (HPDE) runs with the North Atlantic Audi Club

The cost for two days for those who have participated in an HPDE with ANY club is only \$345 which is a great deal. This price is a promotional discount provided until a deadline of March 31st, but I believe that *we are going to be able to extend this rate until April 15th for Mercedes Benz club members*. The rate for those who have NEVER participated in an HPDE is \$345 until April 30th. A single day rate is fixed at \$225 until registration closes (usually a few days before the event, which in this case is the end of May). The regular rate for two days will be \$390 after the discount window closes or until the event is filled to capacity (which can happen). For folks who are new to HPDE's and wish to attend for a single day, they will be required to attend the first day. Experienced people may attend the second day with approval.

There is one potential catch to these rates in that the National organization (the Audi Club of North America) will require membership in the ACNA at a cost of \$45. This is in order that the club have insurance coverage for this event, and comes with membership privileges for the entire year; it also includes a subscription the national quarterly magazine as well as local newsletters and other events we run during the course of the year. Unfortunately, this is something that is difficult to get around because of requirements that have been placed on us operating under their umbrella.
